Regarding PF Lazor (C-73842)

I am writing this to express my sincere interest in the immediate parole of PF Lazor. There is no doubt in my mind that his immediate parole is the highest correct action for the Board of Parole Hearings to take.

I have known PF for about 27 years. I am continually amazed that someone without any prior record with the law has spent so many years in prison for what surely was an act of self defense. Many repeat offenders walk free. Here is man with no prior offense of any kind, who should be free.

I have worked with PF professionally and he is also a friend. I always have friends who are highly educated, upright, and ethical. PF is a reflection of these ideals. I seem to attract good people into my life and I have been fortunate and/or wise in that way. PF is an exact match of the type of person I like in my life. I have 3 children and 3 grandchildren. I am a trained teacher and a graduate of UCLA. I have never even had a speeding ticket. I always follow the law to the best of my ability. In this case, I recommend parole with 100% enthusiasm.

I believe that PF is unfairly imprisoned and should be immediately paroled. I am asking the Board of Parole Hearings to consider the fact that many innocent people do go to prison. For one reason or another this happens. You have only to look at PF's perfect record prior to this incarceration to realize that this is such a case.

He has already paid a very high price for an act of self-defense. I'm sure that he has paid many times over for what he was charged with. Had he been granted another trial, I know he would have been free long ago.

Every person that PF knows or knows of him wants him to be released from prison.

I have no idea what the Board of Parole Hearings uses for criteria to make decisions. You have the difficult task to judge a man without truly knowing him.
