This letter is being submitted on behalf of P. F. Lazor as addendum information regarding his stay at the California Mens Colony from November, 1983 until his transfer to the California Medical Facility, Vacaville on March 8, 1984. Although he was medically limited in his work assignment capacity, he did maintain a clean disciplinary record and positive personal program involvement while he was here. P.F. Lazor spent much time working with staff and inmates in the Chapel, library and on the Quad. Many of his activities led to positive procedural changes that helped reduce problems or streamline areas of concern. He continued to utilize his business acumen in all aspects of his stay at CMC.
