Shortly thereafter the paramedic units arrived and also attempted to aid the VICTIM prior to putting him on a stretcher and placing him in the ambulance for route to the hospital.

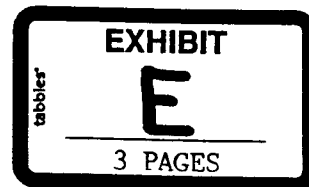
During that time that the above was going on I was able to notice the blood stains on the kitchen rug, the telephone, what appear to be a small caliber automatic, spent casings and other evidence on the floor and in the kitchen area.

I then went outside where Officer Jennings had the SUSPECT handcuffed and at that time I advised him of his constitutional rights, repeating each one after the other and asking him if he understood. The SUSPECT indicated by speech that he understood his constitutional rights and declined at that time to make a statement.

A record check was made of the serial number of the 45 Automatic Pistol which was found in the corner of the small room which is the front room entered from the back door. A weapon manufactured by Arcadia Machine Tool was registered to P.F. LAZOR with the date of birth of 3/1/54 using the address of 16935 Roberts Rd, Los Gatos. It was registered with the Fremont Police Dept on Aug 4, 1982 was given a case number of G228654.

I requested that Officer Campos be contacted and to assist me in the gathering of the physical evidence at the crime scene.

I noticed blood was splattered on the floor and the walls in the kitchen. I also noticed on the floor there was a small long-barreled automatic. It appeared to me at the time to be a possible .22 caliber or pellet gun. It was later identified as a Daisy BB gun.
