THIS PHOTO, THE JURY NEVER GOT TO KNOW ABOUT, SHOWS THE UNOBSTRUCTED VIEW OF MORE THAN 3 STANDARD 12-INCH FLOOR TILE SQUARES BETWEEN THE DOOR WHERE IT'S HINGED ON ITS DOORFRAME ONTO THE WALL, IN A PERPENDICULAR LINE FROM THERE.

THIS UNCONTROVERTABLE PROOF BY THE POLICES' OWN PHOTO, OF AT LEAST A 39-INCH UNOBSTRUCTED OPENING IN WHICH THE 30-INCH DOOR COULD FREELY OPEN, SHOWS THAT AT LEAST 3 POLICE OFFICERS JOINED TOGETHER TO COMMIT PERJURY ON THIS ISSUE, IMPORTANT TO THE VERDICT

THE POLICE PHOTO INTENDED FOR THIS EXHIBIT, PRESERVED FOR MANY YEARS, HAS DISAPPEARED (ALONG WITH OTHERS) FROM MR. LAZOR'S LEGAL FILES IN PRISON, WHILE NEAR COMPLETION OF THIS YEARS-LONG DOCUMENT PREPARATION. THE PHOTO ABOVE IS USED AS AN ALTERNATIVE. ITS VIEW IS SOMEWHAT OBSTRUCTED, BUT SUFFICIENTLY SHOWS THE DOOR OPENING PATH WAS AT LEAST 36- TO 39-INCHES. THE MISSING PHOTO SHOWED THAT THE ITEMS IN THE FOREGROUND (VACUUM & TABLE LEGS IN BASKET) DID NOT OBSTRUCT THE DOOR, AS ALSO VERIFIED BY THE POLICE STATEMENTS CLAIMING ONLY THE LARGE CHAIR OBSTRUCTED IT.
